

Suez Canal transit of LNG is a critical part of Global LNG Trade



- Convergence is taking place in Global Natural Gas Markets
- Contention at major global shipping chokepoints such as the Suez Canal reverberates globally
- LNG Cargoes have ranged between 1% and 7% of Suez
 Canal Traffic, and averaged 3% of Suez total movements in the last 5 years
- But! Suez LNG traffic accounts for at minimum 8%, and sometimes as high as 15% of Global LNG Trade
- The adage "a problem somewhere is a problem everywhere" applies here also
