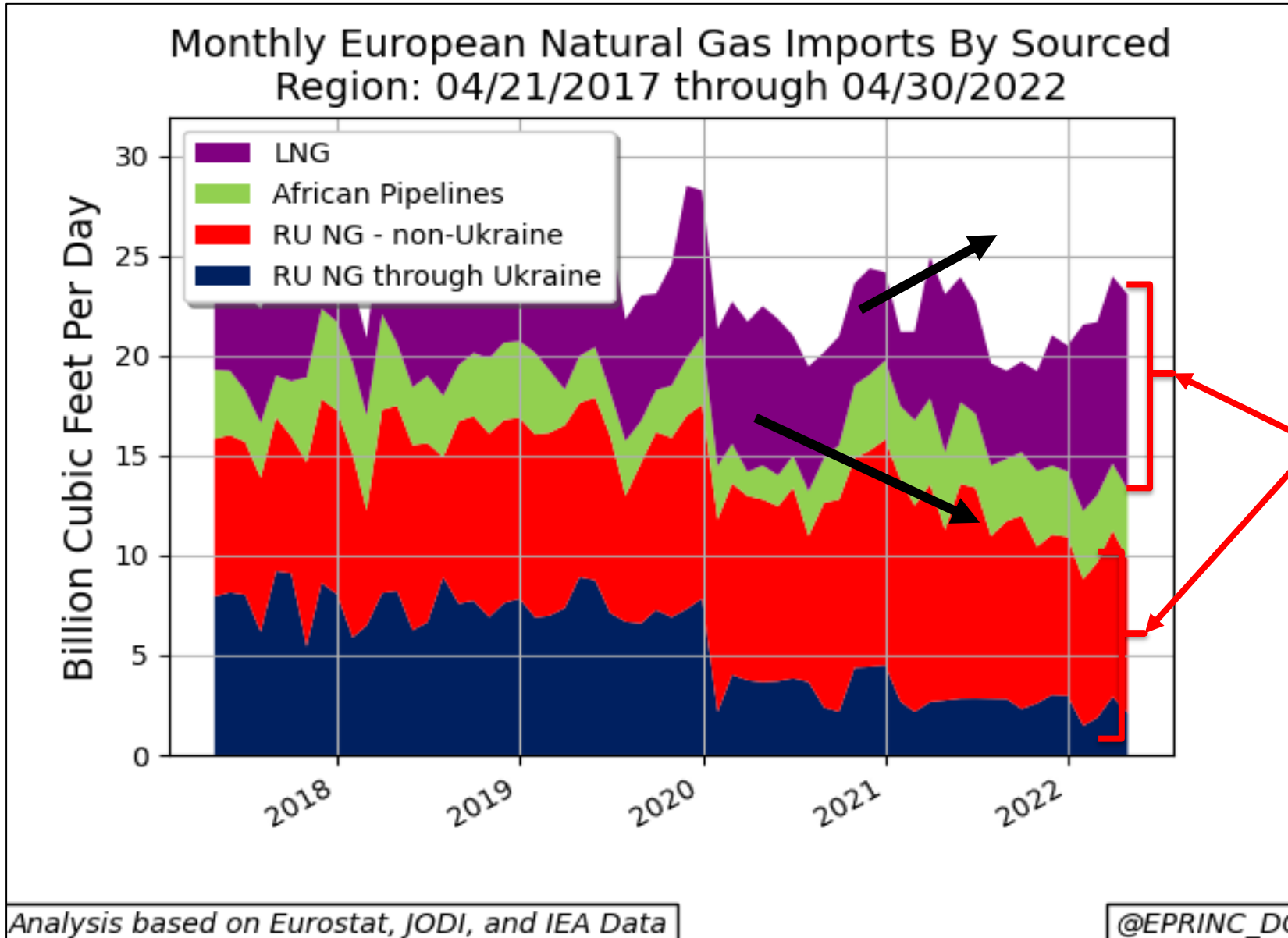

Europe – Recently Reported Monthly Natural Gas Receipts



Even before Russia's February 2022 acceleration of military aggression against Ukraine, two trends were in place:

- 1) Russia's pipeline natural gas exports have been on the decline; and**
- 2) Europe has increased its reliance on LNG imports, notably from the U.S.**

Reviewing the latest Eurostat monthly data, two European natural gas trends were in place even before Russia's February 2022 acceleration of military aggression against Ukraine:

- Russia's pipeline natural gas exports have been on the decline; and
