





## **European Energy Security As Measured by Affordability**



- Energy security is described in three dimensions: availability, acceptability, and affordability.
- A way of measuring energy affordability in Europe is to review country-level industrial electricity prices across the whole region.
- While stable from 2007 through 2021, they spiked in 2022 with Russia's escalation of its war against Ukraine.
- The impact was felt both in Western European countries such as France and Germany, and Central European ones such as Romania and Poland. Overall, this has led to a recessionary trend across all of Europe.
