



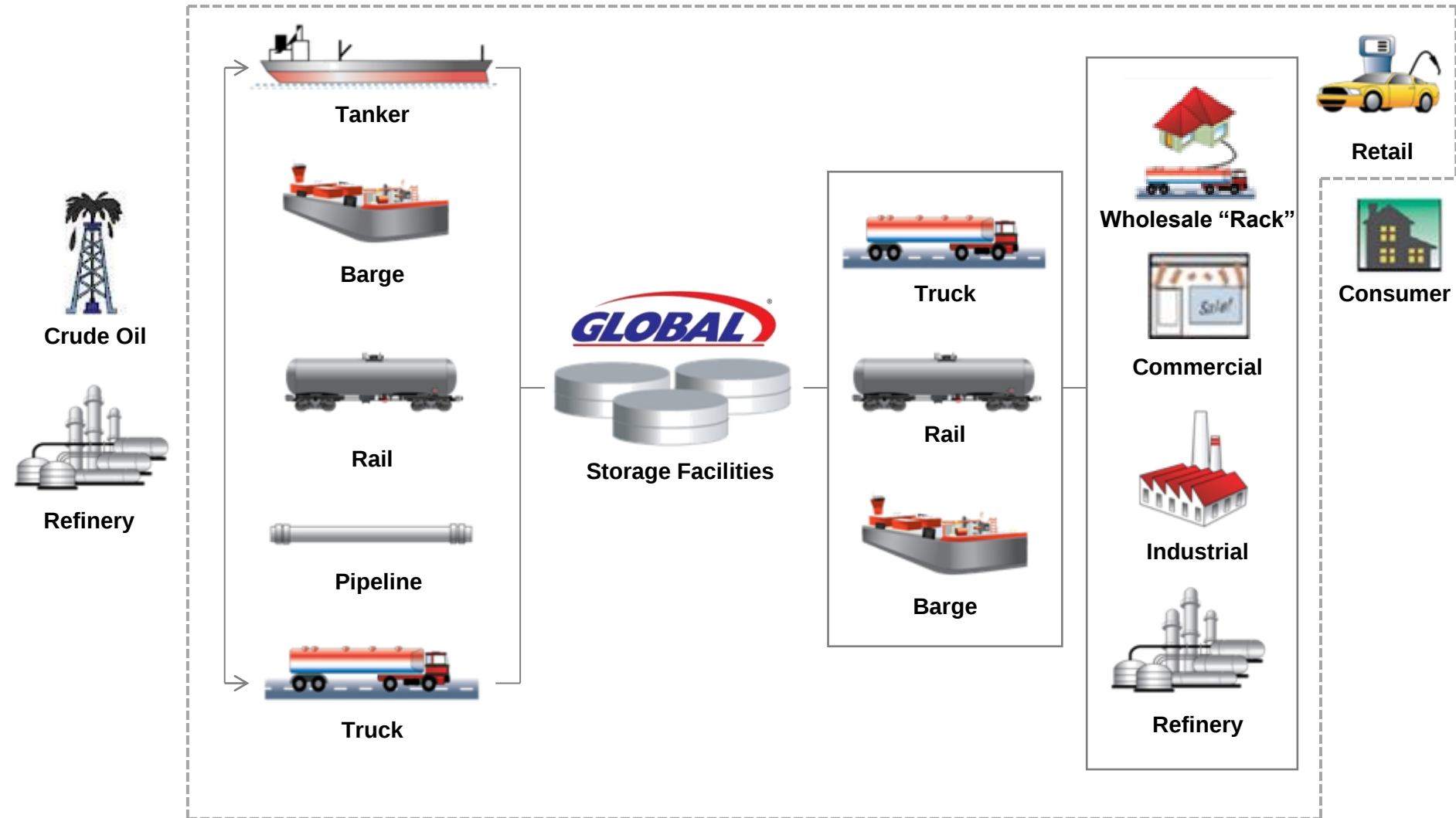

Storage & Distribution of Crude & Energy Products

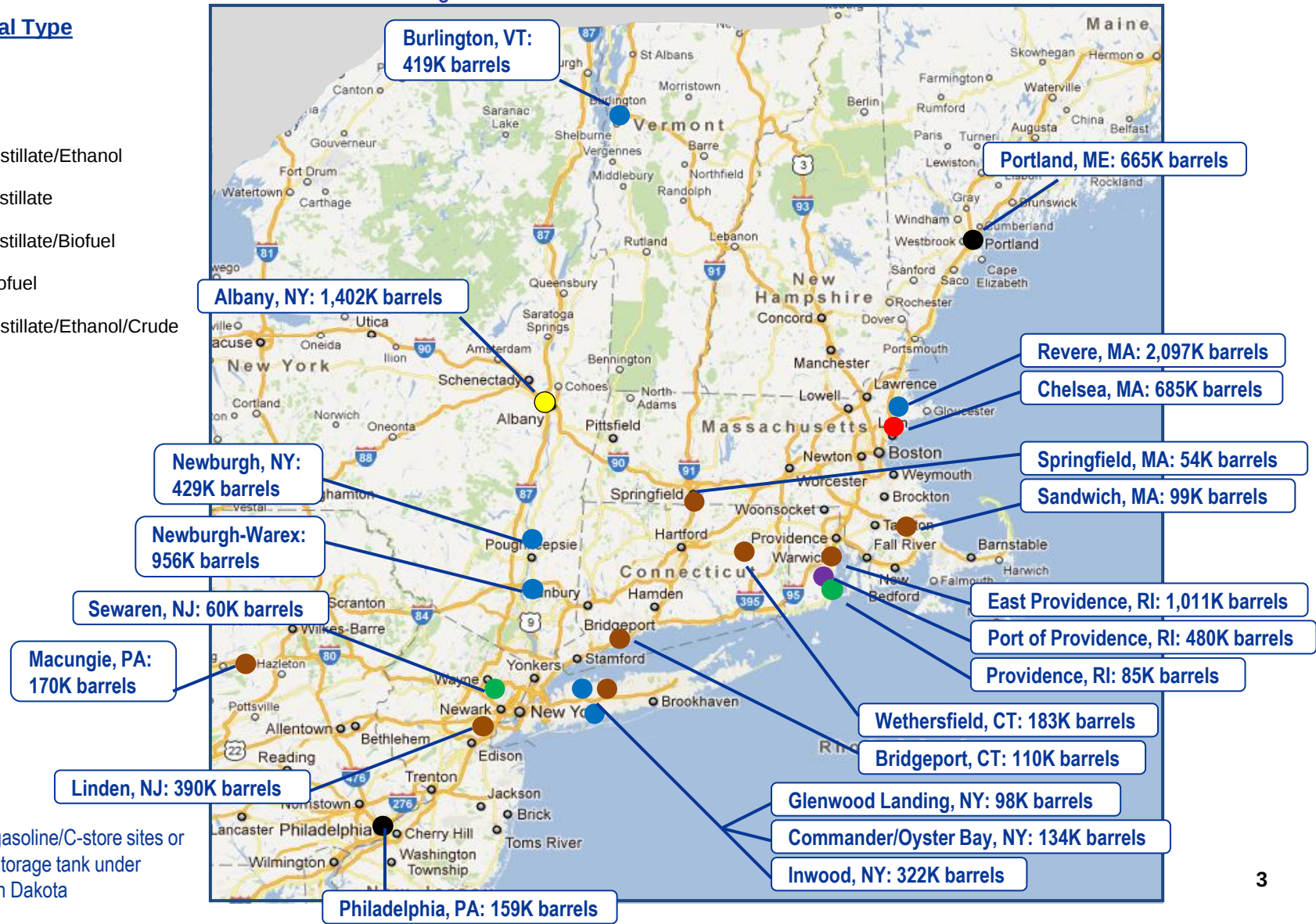


10.2 Million Barrels of Storage Capacity*

One of the Largest Networks of Refined Petroleum Terminals in the Northeast

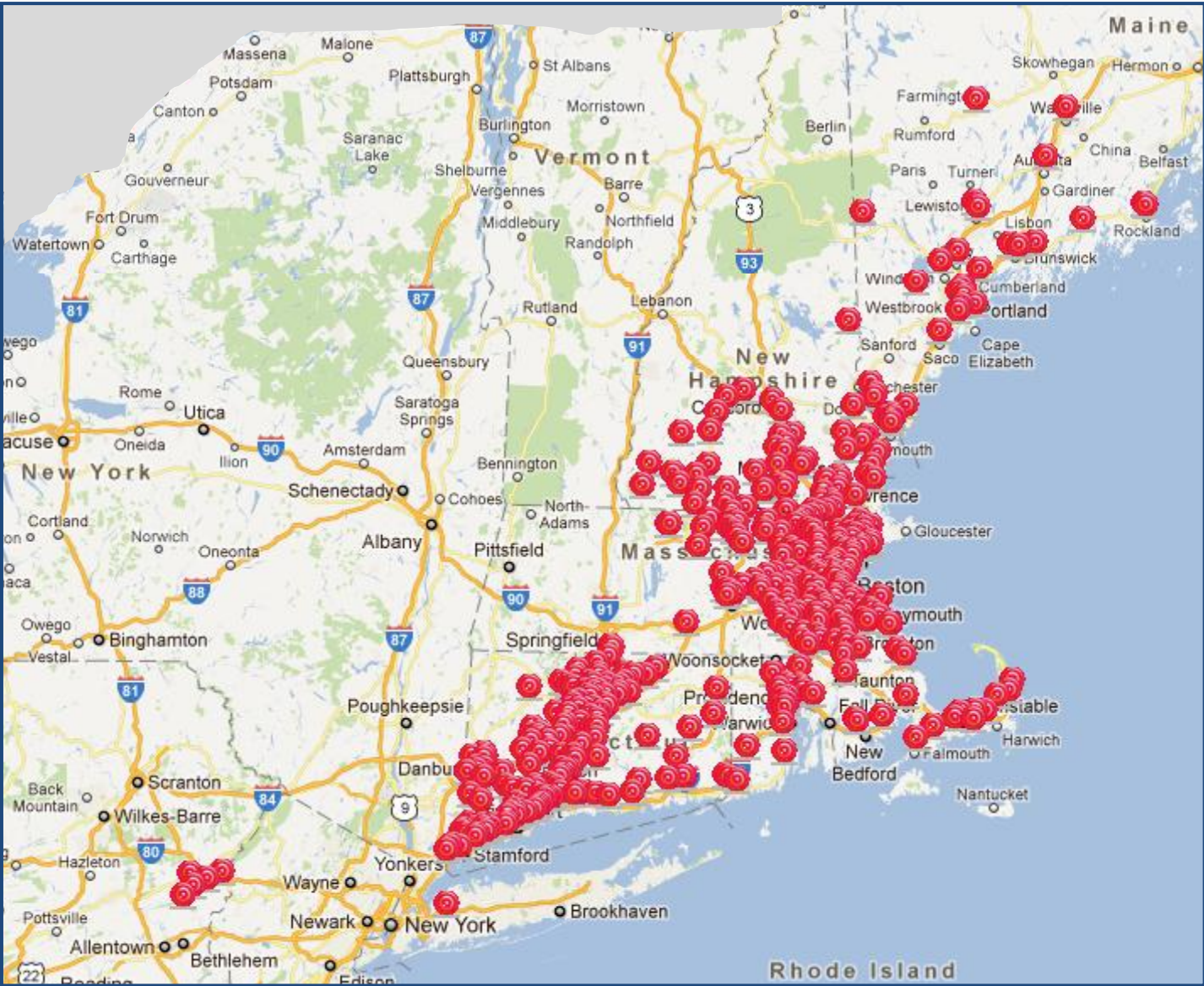
Key to Terminal Type

- Distillate

- Residual/Distillate/Biofuel
- Distillate/Biofuel
- Gasoline/Distillate/Ethanol/Crude

Gas Station Locations



- **Gateway to efficient and cost-effective receipt, storage and delivery of crude, ethanol and other products**
- **Relationship with Canadian Pacific (CP) provides significant routing flexibility**
 - Intermodal terminal linked via single-line to CP
 - Transload facility
 - Completing rail expansion that will enable two 120-car unit trains to be offloaded daily
 - Expansion will more than triple terminal capacity to approximately 150,000 bbls/day
- **Established infrastructure links Global to energy producing regions across North America**
 - Stampede transload facility in North Dakota's Bakken region
 - Product shipped by barge from Albany to East Coast refiners



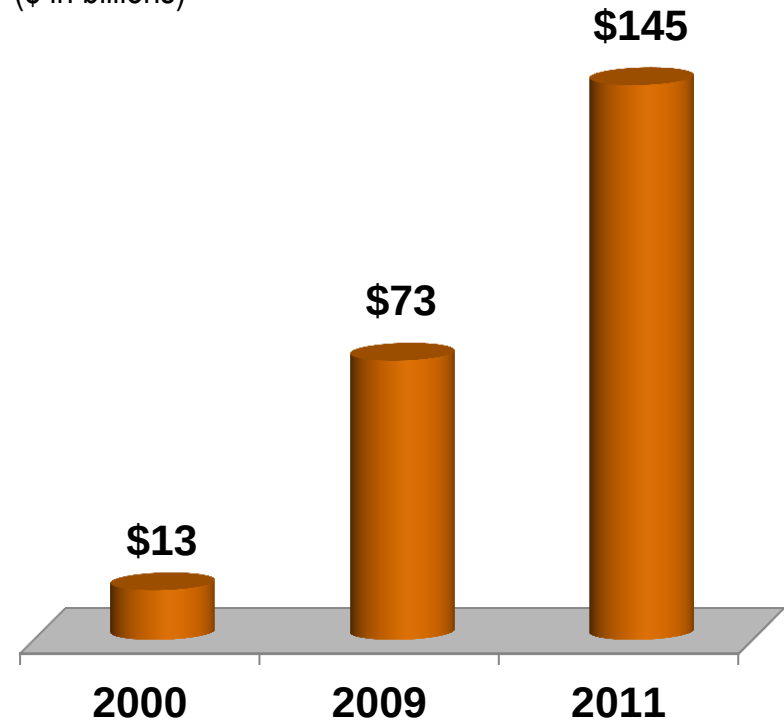
Enhancing Infrastructure in Bakken Region



- **Global is constructing a 100,000-barrel storage tank in North Dakota**
 - Expected to be ready by third quarter 2012
